



WOMEN'S SPECIALTY OUTREACH PROGRAM

Where pregnant women and women with dependent children are a priority for treatment



The Women's Specialty Outreach Program (WSOP) of Catholic Charities of Southeast Michigan (CCSEM) provides **individual and group therapy** specific to women regarding the consequences of alcohol and other drug use including Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorders (FASD). Services include case management, peer recovery support, childcare, transportation to treatment, document replacement services, primary care coordination, and referrals to community resources.

This program is for women who are pregnant, have children and need additional support in sustaining their recovery and keeping their family together. Focus is placed on eliminating substance abuse among pregnant women and mothers with children. The program also seeks to remove barriers that often interfere with the recovery process.



EMPOWERING WOMEN AND ENHANCING RECOVERY

WSOP clients receive access to exclusive **resources** and women-specific **recovery groups** including:

THROUGH WOMEN'S SPECIALTY OUTREACH PROGRAM, QUALIFYING WOMEN WILL RECEIVE:

- Screening for substance use disorder (SUD)
- Screening for case management needs
- Screening of dependent children for health and behavioral needs
- Peer Recovery Support
- Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD) screening
- FASD education
- Treatment resource referrals
- Community resource referrals
- Daycare assistance
- Transportation support
- Document replacement services including for birth certificates, state identification, driver's licenses, and social security

WSOP programs are funded by state and federal funds. Pregnant and postpartum women are a priority for admission to treatment. Any pregnant or postpartum person, as well as any primary caregivers of children, are eligible for WSOP programs. Any parent at-risk of losing custody of their child(ren) is also considered a priority population for substance use treatment admissions.
